Updated Information from Civitan International

Officer Training - The Civitan International Board met recently and voted on and approved that beginning this year, **ALL club officers** will be <u>required to attend/complete training</u> **every year.** This means that no matter if officers are repeats, they will be required to complete training. They are working on having more options for training and that information will be coming soon.

District Director Requirements - some additional requirements have been added to District positions. To be eligible to be GE or DAD, candidate must be a member in good standing with International, Home Club has to be in good standing with International and the candidate has to be a member within the district for at least six months before election. Good standing for a club means, current with dues, all officers are trained and 990 is filed on time.

Appalachian State University Campus Civitan Club (We hope!)




